

# Tackling the Leading Infectious Disease Threats to Child Survival



## **ABOUT THE FORUM**

Despite incredible progress that has halved deaths among children under five since 2000, almost five million children still die each year from preventable causes, with 58% of these deaths occurring in Sub-Saharan Africa.

Ending preventable child deaths and achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) demands collective action.

From 22–24 July 2025, global health leaders, policymakers, philanthropists, researchers, and advocates will gather in Maputo, Mozambique, for the <u>Innovation and Action for Immunization and Child Survival Forum 2025</u>. Hosted by the Governments of Mozambique and Sierra Leone, and in partnership with the Government of Spain, "la Caixa" Foundation, the Gates Foundation and UNICEF, the Forum comes just five years to the 2030 SDGs deadline. Discussions will advance impactful partnerships, strengthen political will and mobilize stakeholders to put in place measures to protect children everywhere against the leading threats to their survival.
